## Article Submission Guidelines:

**Title:** capital letters, Times New Roman, **bold**, font size 14, page centered. The title will be followed by a 1, 5 cm space.

**Author:** (first name, surname): Times New Roman, **bold**, font size 12, page centered; scientific degree.

**Institution:** (University, Laboratory, etc.): Times New Roman, font size 12, page centered. A double space will follow.

**Abstract:** Times New Roman, font size 11, **bold**, *italics*, left side indentation – 15 mm, right side indentation – 15 mm, justified alignment. The abstract will cover 10-12 lines, use the single space (1,0) between lines.

**Key-words:** 5-7 terms, Times New Roman, font size 11, *italics*; use the double space (2,0) between lines.

**Formatting:** Times New Roman, font size 12, justified alignment, 1,5 space

Page format A4 (210 mm X 297 mm), indentation will be set using the “set page” tab, as follows: upper space – 2 cm, bottom space – 2 cm, left side – 3cm, right side 1cm; the text will be presented in a single column, including the title, the author / authors, and the institution they represent, the abstract and the key-words, use the single space format.

**References:** Times New Roman, **bold**, font size 12.

SURNAME (capital letters), first name, (the year of publishing in brackets), Title- *italics*. The place of publishing: city, edition; font: Times New Roman, font size 12, justified alignment. 0.5 space.

Example: AOUROUX, Sylvain (1996) – La philosophie du langage, Paris, P.U.F., 224 p.

In the Reference Section the entries must be numbered and ordered alphabetically on the last name of the first author or title if no author names are available. The references in the text should be in square brackets and use numbers, e.g.: [1]; the full description is given at the end of the article.

**Article Length:** maximum 6-8 pages.

**P.S. The articles that do not meet the requirements will not be accepted.**
